#### STEPS IN US VISA PROCESSING

(with PERSONAL APPEARANCE for biometrics & interview)

##### STEP 1: ASSESSMENT

Read and sign our [Data Privacy Agreement & Visa Waiver](#) then email it together with the accomplished [Questionnaire](#) for Free Assessment, this will allow us to evaluate your chances of approval. Kindly send these to our Visa Department by sending a message through:

##### STEP 2: PAYMENT

After the assessment and should you wish to proceed with the application, our Visa team will then provide your invoice. Proceed to settle then send your proof of payment along with your passport copy and latest 2x2 photo on a white background.

##### STEP 3: ENDORSEMENT & PROCESSING

The Visa Team will endorse you to the next available Visa Consultant, who will verify your payment before proceeding with the processing of your application.

## WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER PAYMENT VERIFICATION

Expected turnaround time based on working days	ACTIVITY / PROGRESS
Day 1-3	<p>Keep your lines open. Your assigned Visa Consultant will reach out to assist you in creating an account within the U.S. Embassy system. Please ensure you have an <b>active email address</b>, as it is required for registration.</p> <p><b>Important:</b> Kindly inform us of any upcoming travel plans or events that may require the use of your passport. This will help your Visa Consultant take these into consideration when scheduling your visa appointment.</p>
Day 4-8	<p>Once your account has been successfully created, your assigned Visa Consultant will proceed with scheduling your <b>biometric and consular appointments</b> with the U.S. Embassy.</p> <p>We will then provide you a copy of your Appointment Confirmation.</p>
Day 9-13	<p>Your assigned Visa Consultant will encode and prepare the draft of your <b>DS-160 (Application Form)</b> and send you a copy for your review.</p> <p>Please carefully check the details and inform your Visa Consultant immediately if there are any revisions or corrections needed to ensure the accuracy of your information.</p> <p>As part of the preparation, your Visa Consultant will also schedule a <b>practice interview</b> with our Visa Department Head—ideally <b>one (1) week prior to your Biometric Appointment</b>—to help you feel confident and well-prepared for the actual interview.</p>
Practice Interview	<p>The practice interview will be conducted <b>one-on-one</b> or as a <b>group session</b> if you are applying with family or friends. It will be held via <b>Zoom</b> by default. If you prefer to use a different platform, feel free to let us know and we will do our best to accommodate your request.</p>
	<p>After the practice interview, your Visa Consultant will provide you with a comprehensive <b>Interview Guide</b> to help you prepare effectively for your actual interview at the Embassy along with your confirmed DS160 (Application Form)</p>
Biometric (VAC) Appointment	<p>Please ensure to bring the following documents on the day of your appointment:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Appointment Confirmation</b></li> <li>• <b>DS-160 Confirmation Page</b></li> <li>• <b>Valid Passport</b> (for identification purposes only)</li> </ul>

U.S Embassy Interview Appointment	<p>Please bring the <b>same documents you presented during your Biometric Appointment</b>, along with your <b>supporting documents</b> (a detailed list will be provided by your Visa Consultant).</p> <p><b>After the interview:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If the <b>Consul retains your passport</b>, it generally means your application has been <b>approved</b>.</li> <li>• If the <b>Consul returns your passport</b>, it indicates that your application has been <b>refused</b>.</li> </ul>
After the U.S Embassy Appointment	<p><b>In the event of approval:</b> If you have opted to <b>personally claim your passport at the VAC (Biometric Center)</b>, you will receive a notification via your active email address once your passport is ready for pickup.</p> <p><b>In the event of refusal:</b> Please coordinate with your assigned Visa Consultant and share the details of your interview, including the questions asked and your responses. This information will help assess the possible reasons for the refusal and allow us to provide appropriate guidance and recommendations should you wish to reapply.</p>

### IMPORTANT NOTES:

- ❖ Applicants are advised to plan accordingly and allow sufficient time for the visa process. It is encouraged to apply three (3) months prior your intended travel date.
- ❖ Each visa application is subject to **individual assessment**, and **processing times may vary** before a schedule can be confirmed.
- ❖ We cannot guarantee 100% approval as it depends upon the discretion of the Consul/Visa Officers but we will make sure that you be 90% sure before your scheduled appearance.
- ❖ Consul will advise the applicant whether their application is granted or not on the day of your appointment.
- ❖ If granted, you will receive your passport with the attached visa copy 5-7 working days after the appearance. PHP 440/passport is collected by LBC upon delivery.
- ❖ We do not require any confirmed Airline Ticket and Hotel Accommodation for every visa application thus in any case of delayed results and/or refusal of application, Travel Online Tours shall not be held liable for the costs of airline ticket/s and hotel accommodation/s.
